



## **Texas Camino Real District Export Council Scholarship Program**

### **Student Scholarship**

1. The DEC Scholarship Program is established to assist undergraduate students majoring in business at qualified Central Texas educational institutions. Student eligibility for the scholarship is based on the following criteria:
  - (a) The student is a declared a business major.
  - (b) The student has an international focus on their studies.
2. Scholarships are available to students enrolled at either Central or South Texas Institutions.
  - (a) Preference may be given to those institutions offering the Export Fellows DEC program.
3. Submission for selection is based on the following:
  - (a) Students to submit either a paper from the Export Fellows Program or submit a paper to the DEC for review.
  - (b) Students to indicate how they would use the DEC scholarship, either for specific courses or for approved independent study, study abroad, cost of tuition, and costs related to internships.
  - (c) The DEC selection committee to review applications.
  - (d) Scholarship Amount(s): \$750.00 per award per student, maximum 2 students annually.
